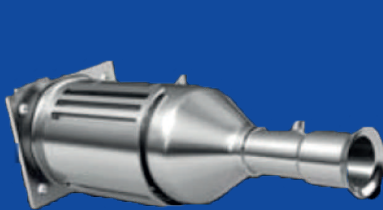


# THE DANGER OF USING LUBRICANTS WHICH DON'T MEET OEM SPECIFICATION
